



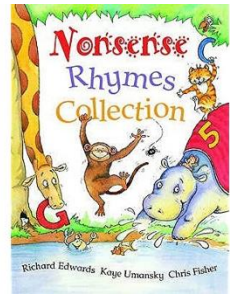

Personal, Social and Emotion Development- Managing Feelings and Behaviour

30-50 months: Aware of own feelings.

Communication and Language- Understanding

40-60 months: Understands humour, e.g. nonsense rhymes, jokes.

You could:

- Play with toys with on/ off switches or with parts you need to make work.
- Play a simple game on a computer, i-pad or phone.

Links to The Early Years Foundation Stage

Understanding the World- Technology

30-50 months: Knows how to operate simple equipment, e.g. turns on CD player and uses remote control.

30-50 months: Shows an interest in technological toys with knobs or pulleys, or real objects such as cameras or mobile phones.

30-50 months: Shows skill in making toys work by pressing parts or lifting flaps to achieve effects such as sound, movements or new images.

30-50 months: Knows that information can be retrieved from computers

40-60 months: Completes a simple program on a computer.

40-60 months: Uses ICT hardware to interact with age-appropriate computer software.



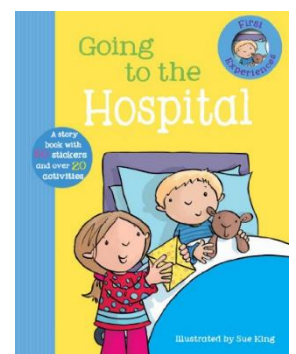
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12th May 2021 International Nurses Day

You could:

- Read a story about going to hospital
e.g. -I don't want to go to hospital by Tony Ross
-Topsy and Tim go to Hospital by Jean and Gareth Adamson
-My first visit to hospital by Rebecca Hunter

- You could share a non-fiction book
e.g. -People at Work in a Children's Hospital by Deborah Fox

30-50 months: Knows information can be relayed in the form of print.

40-60 months: Enjoys an increasing range of books.

40-60 months: Knows that information can be retrieved from books.

- Make a role play hospital

You could

-Use soft toys and dolls as patients

-Take it in turns to be the patient and/ nurse

-Use an old bandage/ piece of material to use as a bandage

-Use paper/ pencils to write patient details/ diagnosis sheets/ appointment sheets/ prescriptions/ telephone messages

Just be creative with what ever you have to hand!

Links to The Early Years Foundation Stage Expressive Arts and Design- Being Imaginative

30-50 months: Engages in imaginative role-play based on own first-hand experiences.

40-60 months: Introduces a storyline or narrative into their play.

40-60 months: Plays cooperatively as part of a group to develop and act out a narrative.



Communication and Language- Speaking

30-50 months: Uses talk in pretending that objects stand for something else in play, e.g. 'This box is my bed.'

40-60 months: Uses language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations.

40-60 months: Links statements and sticks to a main theme or intention.

40-60 months: Uses talk to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feelings and events.

40-60 months: Introduces a storyline or narrative into their play

15th May 2021 International Day of the Family

You could:

- Enjoy a family picnic (outside or inside)

You could

-Make the food together

-Include toys such as balls or a skipping rope

30-50 months: Recognises and describes special times or events for family or friends.

40-60 months: Enjoys joining in with family customs and routines.



17th May World Telecommunication Day

You could:

Support your child to telephone a family member who lives far away.

Support your child to telephone a friend you haven't spoken to for a while.

Links to The Early Years Foundation Stage Communication and Language- Speaking

30-50 months: Beginning to use more complex sentences to link thoughts (e.g. using and, because).

30-50 months: Can retell a simple past event in correct order (e.g. went down slide, hurt finger).

40-60 months: Links statements and sticks to a main theme or intention.

40-60 months: Uses talk to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feelings and events.

May- Spring Activity

When you have finished with your egg box from the Maths Summer 1 Home learning challenge use it to complete the egg box scavenger challenge...

Egg Box Scavenger Challenge

Use an egg box to collect finds on your scavenger hunt.

1. First, decorate the box.
2. Next, cut out the texture grid below and stick it to the lid.
3. Now you're ready to head out and find all the items.

Challenge... can you think of your own words to describe what you find e.g. spiky, bendy, rough, delicate. You could make your own grid!



Variation for younger children- look for things of the same colour. You can make your own grid!

Links to The Early Years Foundation Stage Understanding the World- The World

30-50 months: Comments and asks questions about aspects of their familiar world such as the place where they live or the natural world.

30-50 months: Shows care and concern for living things and the environment

40-60 months: Looks closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change

Communication and Language- Speaking

30-50 months: Uses vocabulary focused on objects and people that are of particular importance to them.

40-60 months: Extends vocabulary, especially by grouping and naming, exploring the meaning and sounds of new words.

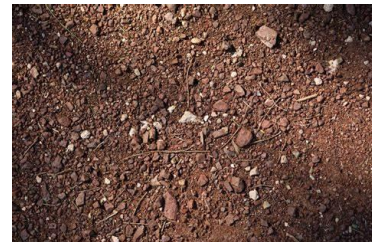

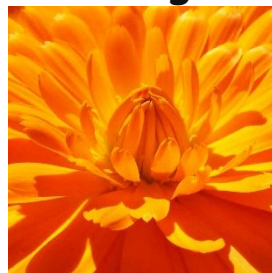
