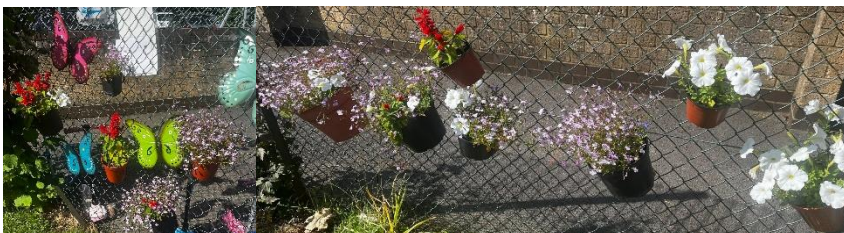


We have been growing Strawberries, tomatoes, lettuces, cabbage, runner beans and courgettes.
